

## **Egremont Board of Health**

**Thursday June 29, 2017, 10:00 am, Egremont Town Hall**

- 1) Chairman Ogden called the meeting to order 10:00 am. The minutes from the June 8, 2017 meeting were reviewed, corrected and accepted.
- 2) **North Egremont Store** three-bay sink and non porous counter installed. Current food menu was submitted with a copy given to BoH members. Jayne strongly felt establishment meets compliance. Board asked that a thank you letter be sent acknowledging their efforts and to keep BoH informed if they add food items to menu.
- 3) **Styrofoam** Board would like this to be brought up at a future meeting.
- 3) **EVI/Main Street** Juliette read excerpts from Nancy Ruderman's final report in which she stated improvements and changes to meet compliance. Jayne has since re-inspected. Establishment given board's full approval and is now back on regular inspection schedule.
- 4) **Fee Schedule** Copies of revised fee schedule distributed to Board. Motion made and seconded to approve with the following change: regular permit fee includes two inspections per year with two follow-up inspections if needed. Vote taken 3-0. Fee schedule will be effective starting July 1, 2017
- 5) **Water Department Shut Off** The four Egremont homes who received shut-off notices have worked out a payment plan with the Water Department.
- 6) **ID Badges** Ellen and Jayne have yet to receive badges. Board thanked Will Brinker for his assistance on this project.
- 7) **86 Hillsdale Road** Recent Title 5 inspection failed due to groundwater levels. Jack Magnotti from Kelly, Granger & Parsons appeared with revised plans. Board reviewed plans and voted to approve (3-0) a one foot reduction to estimated seasonal high groundwater under maximum feasible compliance.
- 8) **Kazi/18 Hilltop** Juliette inspected tank replacement. Revised plans were submitted. Letter to homeowner will be sent advising them to protect reserve area of future leach field if they do driveway repairs.
- 9) **Recent field work** Titles 5 inspections recently performed at 14 Main St (pass), 22 Millard (pass), 14 Pine Crest (pass), 86 Hillsdale Rd (fail)

10) **Anti Fracking Letter** Letters from MAHM were distributed to board asking for Board support of anti-fracking letter sent to Governor. Chairman Ogden asked that this be brought up again at next meeting of July 13th.

11) July meeting schedule July 13 and 27th. Meeting adjourned at 10:45 am.
