- 1) Chairman Ogden called the meeting to order at 10:14 am. The minutes from the February 20, 2020 meeting were accepted with corrections (3-0).
- 2) The Board welcomed Egremont's new Alliance Health Agent Ed Fahey. First order of business for Ed will be inspecting Egremont food establishments. Juliette was asked to contact Jayne Smith to see if her records, notes and worksheets could be transferred to Ed. Juliette will also provide Ed with a complete list of Egremont's Food Establishments with complete contact info.
- 3) **Brenner/10 Mt. View Rd** The septic system leach field was determined to be in groundwater. The Title 5 report will therefore will be determined to be in failure.
- 4) **Straher/24 Lakeside Dr** Mr. Staher did contact Juliette once he received the letter stating the structure on the property is a public safety threat. He stated he will hire someone to perform a perc test and move his future building plans along.
- 5) **Beaver Permit Request/Route 23 Culvert** Beaver Solutions Inc. has applied for a beaver permit. As the request involves breaching a dam and the installation of water flow device, Board of Health will await decision from Egremont Conservation Commission before it is issued.
- 6) **COVID19 Discussion** The Board discussed the need for proper testing and the importance of correct messaging. General questions about BOH responsibilities and protocols during this crisis were also discussed.
- 7) Meeting adjourned at 11:20 am.
