- 1) The review and acceptance of the April 9, 2020 minutes was tabled until the next meeting.
- 2) **Walley/5 Prospect Lake Road** A perc test was performed at this property earlier in the week. It was reported that the emergency repair work was excellent and no evidence of septic breakout was present. The board hopes to see the installation of the upgraded septic system no later than Fall of 2020.
- 3) **Straher/24 Lakeside Drive** The board discussed the letter sent by Al Thorp, which lists the various procedures that will take place in order to determine if the parcel is buildable (wetland delineation, soil testing, topographic survey of the site, etc.). The board felt the wetland delineation should be performed before the perc test is scheduled in the event the perc isn't needed.
- 4) **COVID-19**
 - A COVID-19 Annual Town Election Contingency Plan will be implemented for the upcoming local election on June 26, 2020.
 - A contingency plan for Annual Town Meeting is currently being worked on.
 - A complaint was received regarding a Short Term Rental at 7 Baldwin Hill South. An email to the owner has gone unanswered. Director Haas will follow up and report back on next meeting
 - The state is rolling out a large-scale contact tracing program.
 - The board will be looking for food establishments guidance when restaurants reopen.
 - Board members will continue to join the Friday conference calls given by BCBOHA and Dr. Doyle of BMC.
