

- The current facility, while sub-optimal, does not appear to be an immediate need

The Finance Committee does not recommend, 5 against, 1 absent.

Article 6 Tree removal.

The Finance Committee approves, 4 for, 2 absent.

Article 7 Public transportation for elderly individuals.

The Finance Committee recommends that the Article be amended to reflect the ongoing nature of the financial commitment, since these monies constitute new line items added to the annual budget for elderly transit. Currently there are approximately 5 users of this service.

The Finance Committee further recommends that the Select Board explain the comprehensive plan for elderly transit, including budgeting and staffing. Pending the preparation of such a plan, the Finance Committee will render a recommendation at the Town meeting.

The Finance Committee reserves recommendation until the Special Town Meeting.

Article 8 Local Room Occupancy Excise and Community Impact Fee.

The Finance Committee recommends that the Town create the new section 19 within the Town's General Bylaws.

The Finance Committee approves, 4 for, 2 absent.

Article 9 COVID-19 Compliance Officer

The Finance Committee urges the Select Board to allocate appropriate funds for the part-time services of COVID-19 Compliance Officer *only* until the next Annual Town Meeting in May 2021, or until such time that the Select Board can assess the future need for COVID compliance and monitoring, based on guidance from the Governor and the Commonwealth.

The Finance Committee reserves recommendation until the Special Town Meeting, pending amendment of the Article.
