MINUTES:

The minutes of the November 6, 2018 meeting were accepted as presented.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Board talked about a possible conflict with a Zoning Board of Appeals member but will take no action at this time.

The Board voted not to allow an employee to earn additional paid vacations days because he didn't enroll in the Town's health insurance program, but to allow the employee to gain others days off by working overtime if he so wished.

OLD BUSINESS:

The following articles will be on the warrant for the December 11 Special Town Meeting.  
Extend recreational marijuana facility moratorium to June, 2019.  
\$8,400 for engineering work for a Corrosion Control System at the Water Plant.  
Petitioned article to end negotiations with Charter/Spectrum.  
\$110,000 for the ADA upgrades at the South Egremont School House.  
Approve grant of land for Affordable Housing.

Bruce reported on his meeting with school officials. Lead at the front door and on the outside of the building is an issue. The front door isn't used as the entry way to for students. A barrier can be erected the school building until such time as the exterior can be painted. The district has agreed to paint the interior. Moisture in the crawl space is also an issue as is the fence around the perimeter of the property. The Town has a quote for new fence and may have the funds to do this. The Town of Sheffield has asked the Board to reconsider its vote to withhold payment to the District. The School Committee is meeting on Thursday, November 15 to discuss resolution. The Board scheduled a meeting with its legal counsel for Friday, November 16 at 5pm.

The Board talked about the concepts for sidewalks along Route 23 in the South village. The Board has concerns about both concepts. The Board will make a decision later in November.
