Minutes of February 6, 2019 were approved as distributed.

Old Business:

Mount Washington 911 signage was discussed.

Responders still have concerns about being able to locate a specific property. Town-wide 911 numbers should be adopted by Mount Washington. First responders and State Police are concerned about public safety.

The issue was not mentioned at the recent Town Meeting in Mount Washington. It was suggested the Egremont Select Board send a letter to Mount Washington to explain the need to move this forward; a plan must be developed at the very least. Perhaps Mount Washington can contribute toward equipment. There should also be some recruitment efforts put forward by Mount Washington.

The Municipal Vulnerability Preparation Grant was more involved than first review showed; the application has not been put forward.

New Business:

MEMA has announced another notice of funding for the coming year; there is another funding program that is being introduced. They will be explored to see if Egremont will be eligible for the funds.
