Old Business:

Cooling and warming centers were discussed; the North Fire Station can be used as a transfer center for the time being, as the church in South Egremont is up for sale. The Town Hall generator is being engineered and may not be upgraded until next year; it can be operated manually. Staffing issues were discussed; the COA could possibly provide assistance. For a major incident, an alert call would be sent to all residents; staff would be alerted first. Information about this will be in the next town newsletter and on the website.

Mount Washington 911 signage was discussed. New numbers will be assigned in the town. The timeline is yet to be established.

New Business:

Mount Washington Road engineering funding was approved at the Special Town Meeting held September 17; reconstruction will go forward. The project may take a couple years to be completed.

Miscellaneous:

The Council on Aging met with Walk Boston about pedestrian safety in the North and South villages.
The next meeting will be Tuesday October 8 at Town Hall.
