

Minutes – Egremont Water Meeting 13 October 2016

General:

Minutes of the September 8, 2016 meeting were approved as distributed.

August gallons were 1,061,010; average 35,000 per day. This is approximately one third less than last year at this time. The float demand system seems to be working in regard to cutting down on the amount of water being pumped.

Old Business:

There are still a few meters that exhibit intermittent readings. They will be tested to see if there is something mechanical or possibly a transmitter problem.

Some customers have outstanding balances but are making attempts to pay when they can; this is slowly bringing those accounts up to date.

New Business:

The annual town report has been sent in for inclusion In the FY 2016 Town Report.

There is a need to explore funding for replacement of some of the main water line along Route 23.

Miscellaneous:

The warrant to the Accounting Officer was approved for the September billing commitment in the amount of \$17,741.50.

Abatements in the amount of \$47.00 were approved and signed. There was a billing error in two accounts when the server went down.

The next meeting will be Thursday November 10, 2016 at 3:00PM. The new backup operator will be asked to attend so he can meet the Commission.
