General:

Minutes of the September 12, 2019 meeting were approved as distributed.

Old Business:

September gallons pumped were 1,072,110; average 35,737 per day. Leak detection options were solicited at the MRWA trifecta day and with area water departments. Several companies are being asked to provide quotes for their services.

Meter maintenance and transmitter replacement continues.

Another round of past due letters have been sent out; customers are responding.

USDA has begun the second round of the application for line replacement.

A reminder was included with the recent billing advising of the new rates.

Applications for upgrade to full certification have been sent to the Division of Professional Licensure for N. Stalker.

George Soudant will provide winter plowing and sanding.

New Business:

A letter was received from DEP authorizing the corrosion control system start-up; among the conditions included in the letter are updating the operations and emergency plans. Updates have been started and will be finished soon.

Town Counsel will be asked about moving forward on properties needing liens for past due balances.

The Capital Plan will be developed with assistance from the Finance Committee.

Miscellaneous:

The warrant to the Accounting Officer was approved for the October billing commitment in the amount of \$18,931.60 (586,867 gallons billed).
